

Thank you for trusting our practice to provide your child's anesthesia needs before, during, and after their planned procedure. Please read the information below carefully. These instructions are for your child's well-being and allow us to take the best care of them during their procedure.

Steps to Prepare for your Day of Surgery:

- 1) You will receive two emails. One email will have a link to fill out our patient forms and a link to our financial agreement form (a summary is below). The second email contains a medical clearance form to be completed by your child's doctor. Filling out the forms will help the dentist anesthesiologist develop an anesthetic plan tailored to your child. Complete these forms as soon as possible.
- Complete the phone consultation.
 Prior to your procedure, we will call you to review your child's medical history and discuss the anesthetic plan. We will review pre-operative instructions and address all your questions and concerns.
- 3) Schedule your preanesthetic evaluation with your physician.
 It should be scheduled between two weeks and two days prior to the procedure (one month for adults). It is your responsibility to ensure that we have received the medical clearance from the doctor.
- 4) Expect a phone call from your anesthesiologist the evening before your procedure. Again, you may reach your anesthesiologist anytime at 640-243-4717.

Financial Information:

Anesthesia fees are based on the length of the procedure:

The first hour: \$1350 (This is the minimum charge)

Each additional 15-minutes: \$225

Deposit:

A \$500 deposit is required to book anesthesia services. Please refer to the financial agreement form for more details. This deposit is non-refundable except for illness or cancellation greater than 14 days prior to the scheduled appointment. Failure to comply with instructions relating to eating and drinking, or 2-week notice of cancellation may result in cancellation of the appointment and forfeiture of your deposit. Deposits may be submitted via the link in the email.

Payment for Balance of Anesthesia Services:

After the procedure, the balance for the anesthesia will be presented to you. **Payment arrangement must be made on the day of the procedure.**

Insurance:

We do not accept insurance. Many insurance policies DO NOT pay for anesthesia services for dentistry or have limitations on individual policies. We are an out-of-network provider so you must contact and check with your Medical Insurance Company representative to discuss your specific benefits. Our office will provide you with a detailed "Anesthesia Statement of Services" at the conclusion of the procedure.
